What Is Rec-PAC?



Rec-PAC is a six-week, structured recreation program operated by the Fairfax County Park Authority for elementary school children. Participants enjoy activities such as fitness, indoor and outdoor games, team sports, nature, crafts, special events, talent shows and play sessions. Weekly activities incorporate character-building activities. A ratio of at least one staff person to 18 participants is our standard. Our enthusiastic leaders include college students and school teachers who bring a variety of skills.

Tech Adventure Camp

Tech Adventure Camp (TAC) is a weekly exploratory camp designed to give students the opportunity to explore STEAM, culinary, health, trades, business and marketing areas. The camp is open to students in grades K-6 during the 2022-23 school year.

Eligibility: Open to students in grades K-6 during the 2022-23 school year. Space is limited and registration is on a first-come basis until seats are filled.

Classes and Daily Schedule

Students are divided into groups based on their grade level during the time of registration. Students in kindergarten - 2nd grade will focus on STEAM, coding, health, and family and consumer sciences (FCS). Students in grades K - 6 will rotate through 5 classes every day. Their classes are STEAM, health, trade and industrial, FCS, and computer science.

2023 Themes and Course Descriptions

- **Week 1: All Fun and Games** We're all about having fun and playing games this week! Come join us for an exciting week of making games, playing games, and having a hoopla!
- **Week 2: Crazy Cool Careers** Learn about exciting careers related to Career and Technical Education! We're exploring uncommon careers and performing tasks related to these unique career opportunities.
- **Week 3: CTE Safari** Are you wild about animals?! We are too! This week we're exploring the animal kingdom, building habitats, and learning more about caring for animals.

Lunch:

Students will have a 30-minute lunch break every day. Additional information will be provided as it becomes available.

Transportation:

There is bus transportation from select FCPS high schools and middle schools. Transportation to and from these schools is the responsibility of the parent or guardian. Transportation information will be communicated to families prior to the start of the program.
